

This year Ash Wednesday falls on Valentine's Day. Having your forehead marked with ashes in the sign of the cross and being reminded that "you are dust and to dust you shall return" is certainly not how Hallmark is advertising Valentine's Day on their greeting cards. While Ash Wednesday and Valentine's Day may seem like polar opposites, I think they do have a strong common thread: love. On Valentine's Day we celebrate love and in its own way, we celebrate love on Ash



Wednesday too: we give thanks for God's love for us.

Nadia Bolz-Weber says this about Ash Wednesday: "If our lives were a long piece of fabric with our baptism on one end and our funeral on another, and we don't know the distance between the two, then Ash Wednesday is a time when that fabric is pinched in the middle and the ends are held up so that our baptism in the past and our funeral in the future meet." At both baptisms and funerals we proclaim God's unending love for all humanity. We recognize that even before we could choose God, God chose us. We name that while we make choices that harm ourselves and others with our words and actions, God's mercy and forgiveness never cease. We remember that God's love for us is not dependent on what we do, God loves us because God is love (1 John 4:16).

God created the first human from the dust and breathed life into him (Genesis 2:7). On Ash Wednesday we remember that God created humanity from the dust of the earth and that when we die our bodies will return to the earth. On Ash Wednesday we remember that we are mortal, we only have so much time on this earth. We also remember that in life and in death we are never separated from God's love and grace.

Treasurer's Report: Jodi reviewed the financial reports for the month of December. With five Sundays in December, as well as the Children's Christmas Program and the Christmas Eve worship, total income was \$2,500 more as compared to October 2023. Motion by Debbie S. to approve the Treasurer's report. Rick seconded. MMSP.

President's Report: Sandy Stetzer announced that Mindoro Lutheran Council will have three new members beginning next month: Cindy Thompson, Daina Dobbs, and Nick Yanske. The council thanks Rick Dobbs, Debbie Peterson, and Cindy Tracey for their years of service. Sandy met with the finance committee last month to help develop the budget. She is considering attending the "So You're On Church Council" meeting in West Salem on February 17th, 2024.

Team Reports:

Finance Team Report: Budget for the year 2024 was developed and Jodi presented the proposed budget on behalf of the Finance Team, going through each budget line with the council. Specifics detailed in the budget included adjustments in salaries for church staff, health insurance coverage changes for Pastor Emma, and parsonage/housing budget changes anticipated for 2024. There was extensive discussion on some of these changes proposed and the Mindoro Lutheran Council members suggested adjustments to the proposed budget. This would need to be further addressed with the finance team and potentially the LV council. There was no motion/vote to approve the budget as of the end of the meeting due to there needing further clarifications and discussions. Plan will be to have final decisions and approval prior to the Annual Meeting scheduled for Feb 4th, 2024.

Delegation La Crosse Synod to sister synod, Iglesia Synod in Peru

The La Crosse ELCA Synod has over 70 congregations walking together in their faith. They are partnered with all of the ELCA synods in the United States. In addition, the La Crosse Synod has sister synods in the world, Peru and Czech Republic are two of the sister synods. In the summer of 2024, there is a selected delegation set to travel to the Iglesia Synod in Peru to connect and walk in encouragement with their faith journey, mainly bases in Lima. They have struggled due to political unrest and economic challenges. Their pastors work full time in other jobs and carry on their ministry when they are able to.

Sharon Pfaff was fortunate to be selected as part of the delegation. The trip was supposed to be in July of 2023, but safety concerns in the country led to a postponement. The delegation has had several group meetings at the synod office since 2022 to learn more about Peru and their challenges.


