Spring Greetings to you!

At a recent joint Mindoro & Lewis Valley Council meeting, we talked about the Scrip Card program that we have at our congregations. It became clear that not everyone knew what this program was. So, in this newsletter we want to help make clear what the Scrip Card program is.

Essentially the Scrip Card program is a gift card program: Mindoro & Lewis Valley Lutheran Churches buy gift cards at a



discount and sell them to congregation and community members for the full value and so the congregations make a small amount of money for each gift card purchased.

Because our congregations are non-profit organizations, we can purchase gift cards from some businesses at a discount. For example, we can purchase a \$100 Kwik Trip gift card for \$95. So congregation members and community members can purchase \$100 Kwik Trip gift cards from Mindoro & Lewis Valley Lutheran Churches and our congregations make \$5 from each of those gift cards. So, you pay \$100 and get a \$100 gift card, but because the congregations purchased the gift card for \$95, we make \$5 from that purchase.

So, if you regularly shop at Sam's Club, Kwik Trip, Woodman's or other stores on the list: you can buy Scrip Cards (gift cards) from Mindoro & Lewis Valley as an easy way to complete your regular purchases while also raising some funds for our congregations!

One of the sheets of paper in this newsletter is the Scrip Card order form. You can fill out this form and bring it to the church office or contact our Treasurer, Jodi Anderson, if you'd like to make an order. Order forms are always available on the entryway tables at both congregations and on our church website. You can order gift cards anytime. Depending on which cards you purchase, cards may be available the same day you make the order or it may take a couple of days to get the cards.

The Scrip Card program hasn't been very active lately, so as the joint council we wanted to promote it and then assess engagement over the coming months before deciding to continue, reduce, or stop the Scrip Card program.

Are you asking "What's a scrip card and why should I buy it from the church?"

A scrip card (not to be confused with a script) is the same as a gift card. Just like a gift card, you purchase them for their face value. The big difference is: when you purchase a gift card, other businesses (Walmart, Festival, Walgreens, Kwik Trip, etc.) are profiting from selling them. BUT when you purchase a scrip card from our churches, the churches profit from it by receiving a percentage of the face value. You pay for and receive the face value of the card - just like you would with any gift card - and the church receives free money simply from you purchasing them from the churches. In this newsletter is a Scrip Order Form. Look through the order form; there are many merchants listed. Pick the cards you need, fill out the form, write your check to either Mindoro Lutheran or Lewis Valley Lutheran, and give it to Jodi or Mona - or mail it to the church: PO Box 167, Mindoro WI 54644. Jodi will do the rest!

With confirmations, graduations, and weddings coming up, they would make great gifts. Or - you can buy them for yourself to purchase your groceries, gas, medications, supplies, clothing, breakfast/lunch/dinner out, etc...


