Confession and forgiveness (p. 94) or thanksgiving for baptism (p. 97) may begin the service.


Gathering Song

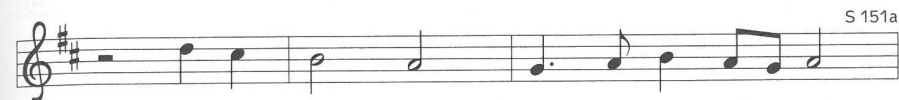
