SCHOOL KITS

- * Four 70 count wide or college rule notebooks, approx. 8"x11"; no loose-leaf paper.
 - * One blunt scissors (safety scissors with imbedded steel blades work well)
 - * One 30-centimeter ruler, or a ruler with centimeters on one side and inches on the other
 - * One pencil sharpener
 - * Five unsharpened #2 pencils with erasers, secure together with a rubber band
 - * Five black or blue ballpoint pens (No gel ink), secure together with a rubber band
 - * One eraser approximately 2.5" long
 - * One box of 16 or 24 crayons
 - * One sturdy drawstring backpack-style cloth bag approximately 14" x 17" with shoulder straps (No standard backpack)
- All items should be new. Remove excess packaging. Pack all the above items in the cloth bag and close.**

FABRIC KITS

- * Two pieces of cotton or cotton blend fabric (NO knits or 100% polyester); fabric should have no stains or holes and be cut into pieces measuring; 2 1/4 yards of 60" wide fabric, or 3 yards of 44" wide fabric, or 4 yards of 36" fabric.
 - * Two spools of matching general purpose thread
- Wrap sewing notions inside fabric and tie with string, yarn, or strip of fabric.**

GUIDELINES FOR ALL KITS

- - - Please give new items only, except where otherwise noted. Please do not donate items with any religious symbols, messages, or your congregation's name. Please do not donate items decorated with a U.S. flag, patriotic or military symbols, or references to the armed forces, including camouflage. **Do not add other items or leave out any of the items listed.** No plastic bags.

BABY CARE KITS

- * Two light weight cotton t-shirts
 - * Two long or short-sleeved gowns or sleepers (without feet)
 - * Two receiving blankets, cotton or flannel, crocheted or knitted with lightweight yarn, up to 52" square
 - * Four cloth diapers, flat fold preferred
 - * One jacket, sweater or sweatshirt with a hood, or baby cap
 - * Two pairs of socks
 - * One hand towel, dark color recommended
 - * Two bath size bars (4-5 oz) of gentle soap - original wrap
 - * Two diaper pins or large safety pins
- Gently used, clean items (no stains or tears) can be substituted for new ones. **Wrap items in one of the receiving blankets and secure with diaper pins.**

PERSONAL CARE KITS

- * One bath-size towel (approximately 52"x 27"), dark color
 - * Two bath-size bars of soap, (4-5 oz) any brand, original wrapping
 - * One adult-size tooth brush in original packaging Toothbrush multi-packs may be used by sealing an individual toothbrush in a business envelope - no plastic bags or wraps
 - * One sturdy comb, remove packaging
 - * One metal nail clippers, remove packaging
- All items should be new and in good condition. **Wrap items in the towel, and tie securely with ribbons or yarn.**

The family will contact the Funeral Committee or circle. The family will decide on the approximate number of people attending and the food to be served.

When the deceased is a church member, the family will be responsible for the cost of the sandwich furnishings and any specific food ordered. Circle and church members will provide other food.

In regard to non-members, the family will be responsible for furnishing the food. The W-ELCA will prepare and serve the food provided.

Children and spouses of members of Mindoro Lutheran Church will have the same fees as members.
